

The Challenge

- 1/3 of all violent crime is connected to the NTE
- 1/4 of all Robberies
- 1/3 of all Criminal Damage
- One in five violent incidents take place in or around pubs and clubs – 13000 incidents each week
- 3/4 Violent offences in pubs 1/4 in nightclubs
- Perception of crime / Fear of crime

The Challenge

- 2009/10 Govt spending on alcohol awareness and information campaign is £17.6m
- Drinks industry – £800m promoting alcohol
- 25% UK population is “hazardous / harmful” drinker = 75% of all alcohol sales

Who's at risk?

- 17 years to 24 years most at risk – male and female
- $\frac{3}{4}$ of all victims will be male
- 50% of all altercations are between males
- $\frac{3}{4}$ of all victims have no previous convictions
- Binge drinkers five times more likely than regular drinkers to have been involved in a group fight in public

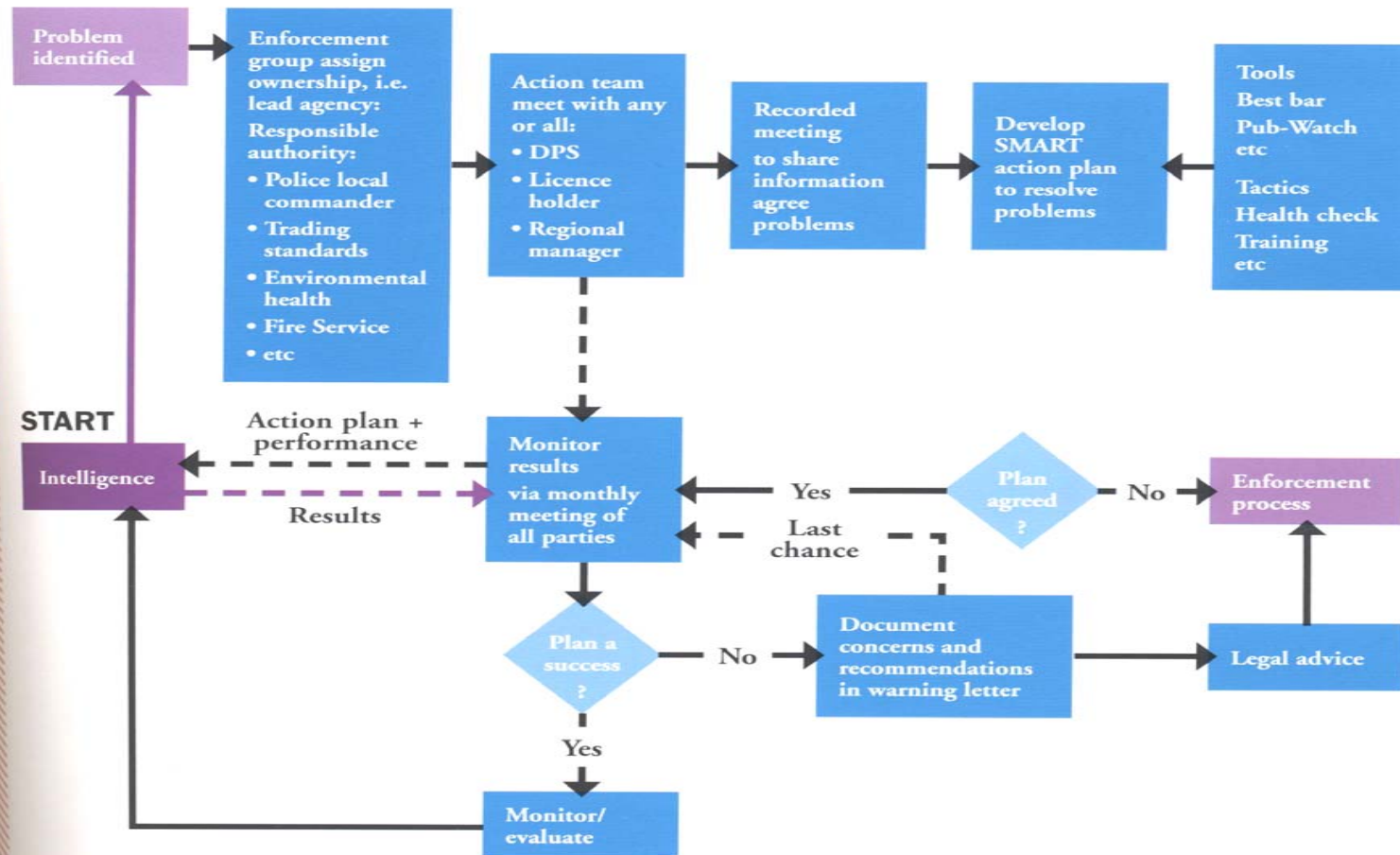

PROBLEM LICENSED PREMISES PREVENTION PROCESS ROUTE MAP



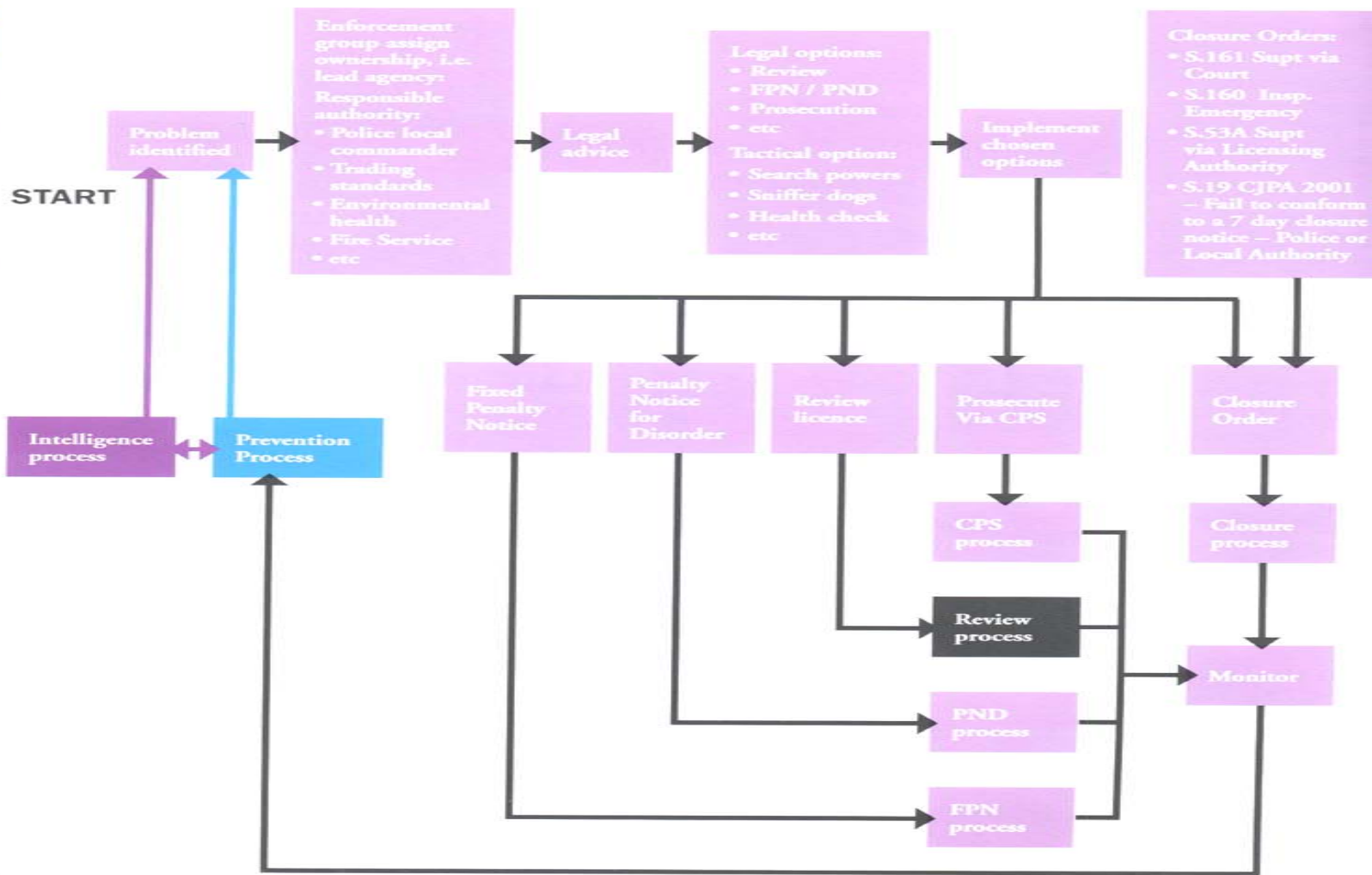

Police Powers

- Sec 57(5) Power to require production of Premises Licence
- Sec 59(2) Power to enter Premises at any reasonable time to determine a relevant application and Sec 59(4) power to use reasonable force
- Sec 94(7) Power to require production of CPC for examination
- Sec 97(1) Power to enter and search CPC where an offence is reasonably believed to be being committed under MDA 1971 (Supply/Offer/Concerned with supply, 97(2) may use reasonable force
- Sec 109(5) Power to require production of TEN for examination
- Sec 135(2) Power to require production of Personal Licence
- Sec 136 Unauthorised Un Licensable activities

Police Powers

- Sec 143(4a) request for PC to a Licence Premises to expel a person who is drunk or disorderly or to assist in preventing entry of such person
- Sec 179 Power of entry to determine premises use for licensable activity and may use force
- Sec 180 Right to investigate offences, may enter and search any premises in respect of which he has reason to believe that an offence under the act has been or is being or about to be committed may use force
- Sec 160 Closure Order – Supt
- Sec 161 Closure Order – Insp – (There is, or is likely to be disorder in the vicinity related to premises – closure public safety OR A public nuisance is being caused by noise – closure to prevent nuisance)
- Section 19 CJPA 2001 – Closure Notice (Police & Authorised LA)
